### **Department of Public Works Guidelines for sand and gravel excavation**

For reference, please see Gravel Excavation and Restoration Plan – Sanford Survey and Engineering Map GRE09E13057

The Gravel Excavation and Restoration Plan contains notes on site management, construction, safety, stormwater management, erosion control, seeding, and groundwater district notes, which outline the parameters of the site use. Interested parties are encouraged to consult the surveying and engineering maps for information on these topics.

The following guidelines for use of the property by DPW are incorporated in the survey maps or are a result of meetings with the public and adoption by the Board of Selectmen.

#### Site Safety:

- The entrance to the site will be maintained in a secure manner, gated and locked when not in use, natural and manmade barriers will be maintained to prevent alternative access and signage shall be posted to delineate excavation.

#### General Management:

- Hours of Operation: 7AM to 5PM unless by Emergency
- Minimum setbacks of 25' to Wetlands and Streams, 50' to property lines, and 150' to dwellings will be maintained.
- A buffer of 100' will be maintained between the site work and the northern wall of the Greenvale Cemetery
- No fuel, lubricants, or other toxic or polluting materials will be stored on-site
- Depleted areas of 1.5 contiguous acres (5 acres Max) will be reclaimed within 2 years of depletion
- Estimated number of days in use per year: 10-20 unless by Emergency
- Noise Control will be achieved through the use of stockpiles, embankments and natural vegetation to buffer noise from abutting properties
- Dust Control will be achieved by an ongoing watering of calcium-chloride additive on an as-needed basis

#### Greenvale Cemetery:

- The Greenvale Cemetery is governed by the Cemetery Trustees
- A close coordination with the Trustees is essential for the maintenance of a serene atmosphere at the Greenvale cemetery
- Greenvale Cemetery is opened and closed annually at the discretion of the Trustees as weather permits.
- Cemetery Trustees will provide notice of scheduled services to DPW and the Selectmen's Office
